“How do I know my child will be safe at MABC?”

We take the care of our children very seriously at MABC. Every class or event has at least two workers in the room. Adults who work with children and youth undergo a nationwide criminal background check. Additionally, when a pre-school child is dropped off, the parent is given a card with a unique number for that child. If the parent is needed, that number can be displayed on the screen during worship. When it is time to go home, the parent has to return the card before they can pick-up their child. In special situations, such as children with handicaps, we even have pagers for more direct communication with parents. Our commitment is to always provide a safe, loving environment for every family.
